







Food prices have been changing drastically. The Food and Agriculture Organization (FAO) counted that the average world market food price increased 20.7% from February 2021 to February 2022, particularly noticeable in the sale of oil, dairy products, cereals, and meat. Covid-19 is believed to have been a major cause of the fluctuation. Yet, the eruption of the Russo-Ukrainian War is about to cause an enormous food crisis and raise food prices much further since the two states account for approximately 30% of global wheat exports. The countries that depend on Ukrainian and Russian products have already suffered severely. The continuation of the war can make food prices too high for many more people in the future.
